Group Size: 10 minimum, 12 maximum per group

Lead by: Trained facilitators (Those who have been divorced will be evaluated by a psychologist to ensure their stability.) 2 facilitators per group will be assigned.

Entry: Must register for the program and pay \$35.00 for the book and program. *An application is available if a reduced or free fee is needed.

Rotation: Begin a new group every 3 to 4 weeks, or as soon as we have 10 to 12 new registrants.

• New participants cannot be added after the first week to allow intimacy, confidentiality, and trust within the group.

Guidelines for participation: Must have filed for divorce, be in the process of a divorce, or have been abandoned by the partner.

• A separate class will be held on the thirteenth week of the program as an optional meeting for participants who are interested in looking into annulment. This program will be taught by our program preist and nullity advisor Monsignor John Duncan.
